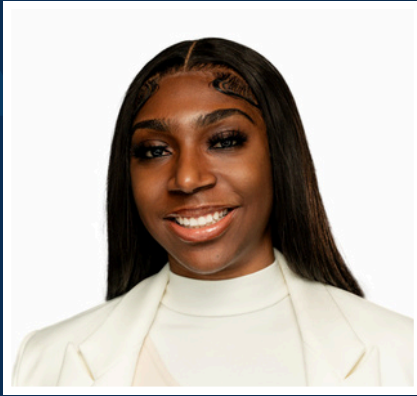
Jill Hathaway

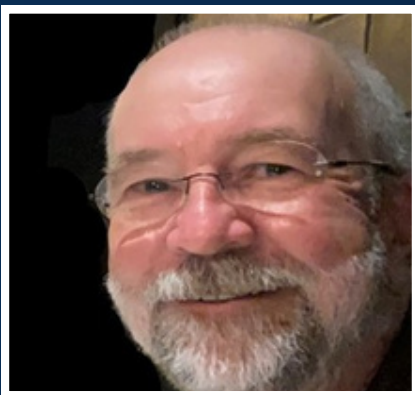
Maria Meyers
